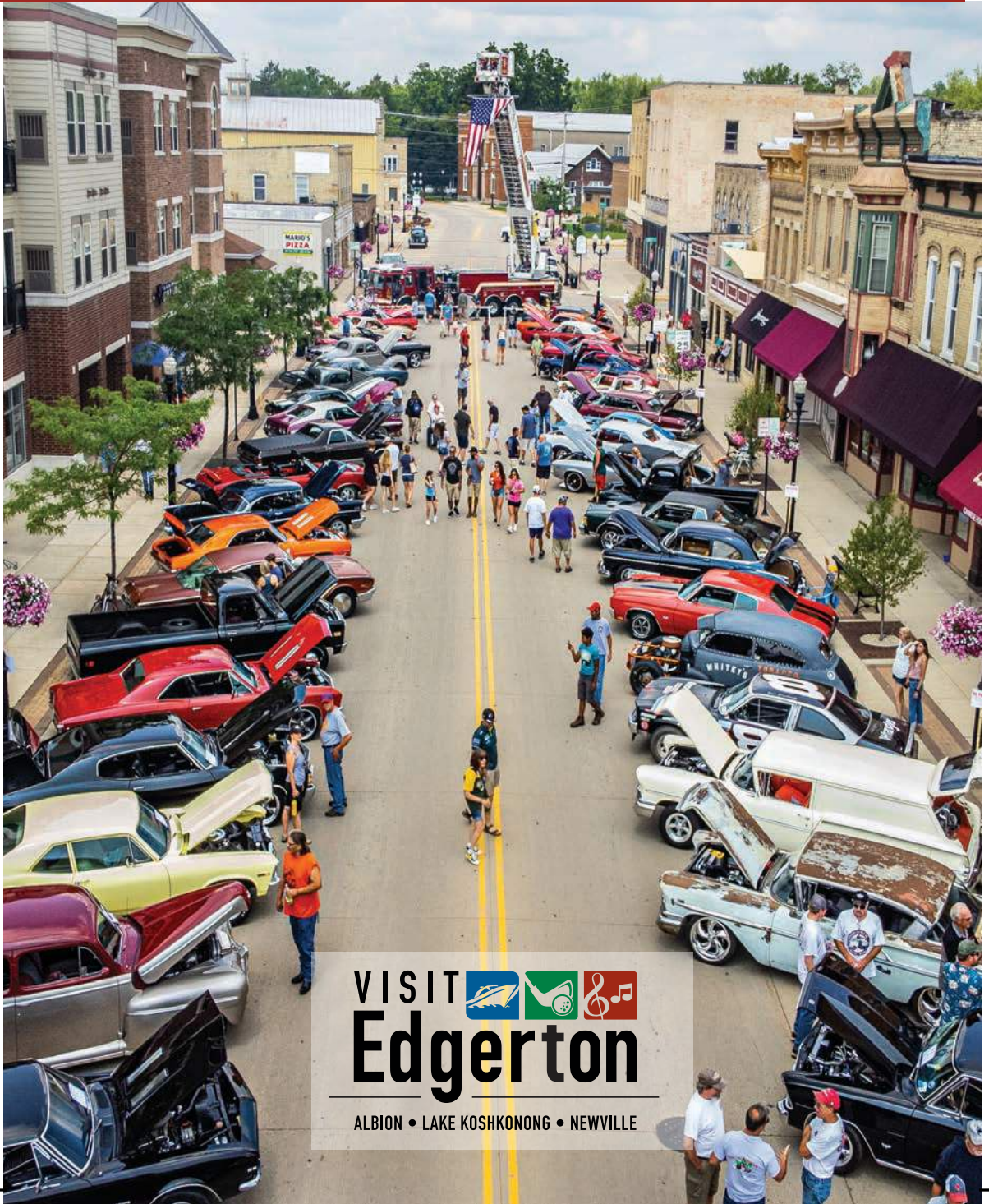

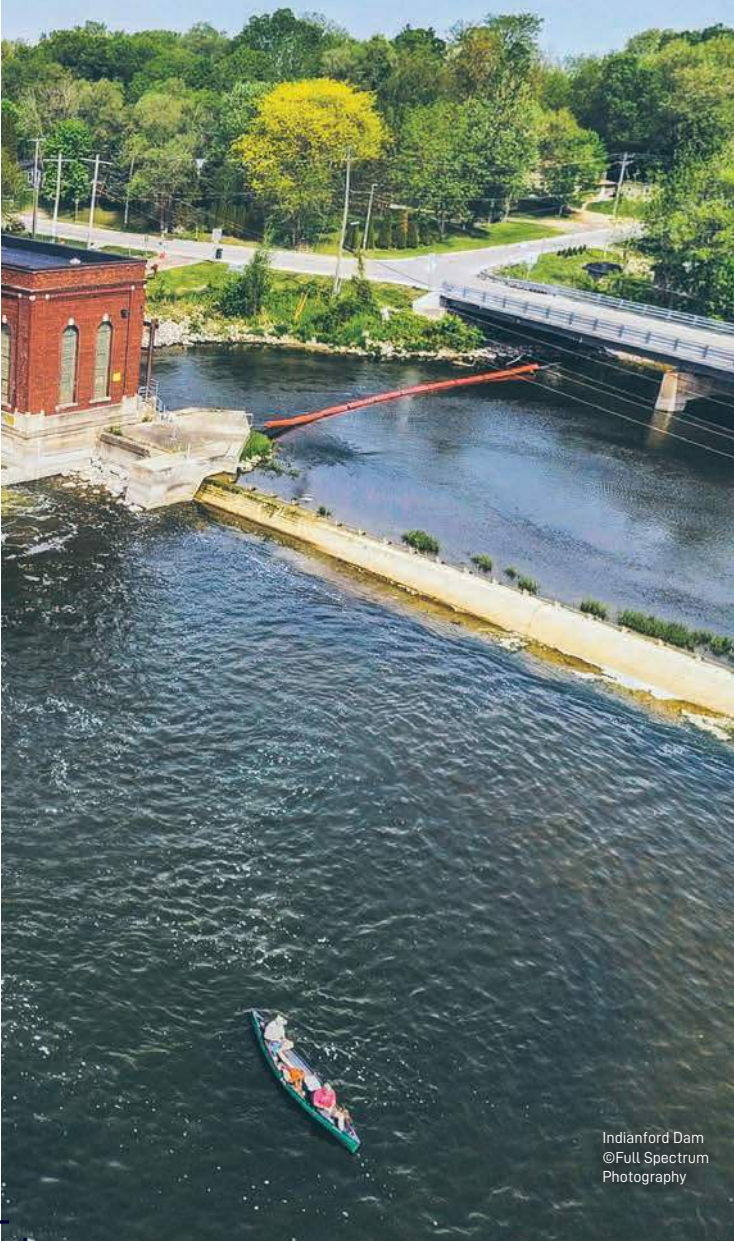

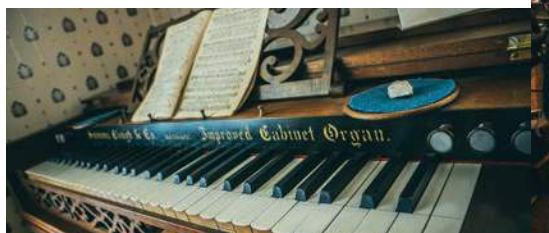

Lake Koshkonong & Beyond

From fishing to boating and fun with family and friends, “the Kosh” is the ideal place to get on the water and away from it all.

Lake Koshkonong offers opportunities for **boating, swimming, fishing, and water sports** with easy access to public boat landings and beaches. As you float around the lake, you’ll also find several establishments with boat parking where you can enjoy a cool drink, a bite to eat, and live music.

If fishing is your thing, you’ll find plenty of great spots to catch **musky, panfish, largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, northern pike, walleye, and catfish**. Lake Koshkonong is a 10,595-acre lake with a maximum depth of 7 feet.

The lake and surrounding wetlands are home to a diverse ecosystem where you might spot **American White Pelicans and Sandhill Cranes**. Visit the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resource’s website to learn more about Lake Koshkonong’s wildlife, and recreation.

“The Kosh” also offers winter recreation when it becomes a chilly playground for **snowmobiling and ice fishing**.

In addition to Lake Koshkonong, the Rock and Yahara Rivers provide scenic options for fishing, kayaking, and canoeing.

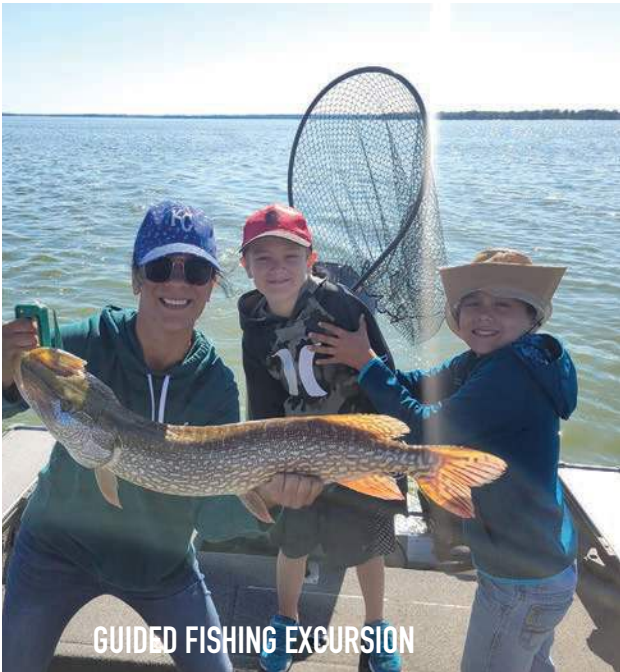

Tobacco Heritage Days

Tobacco Heritage Days, held annually each July in downtown Edgerton, is a three-day family-friendly festival that celebrates Edgerton's rich past in tobacco farming. 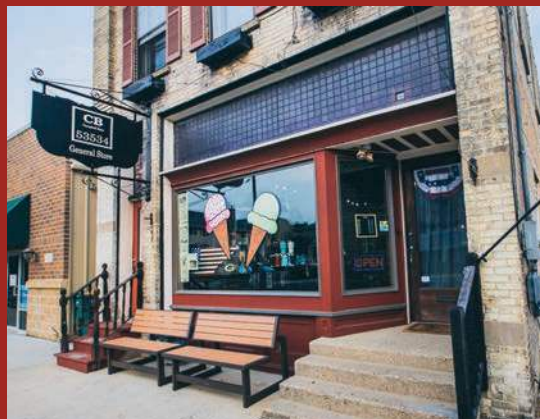

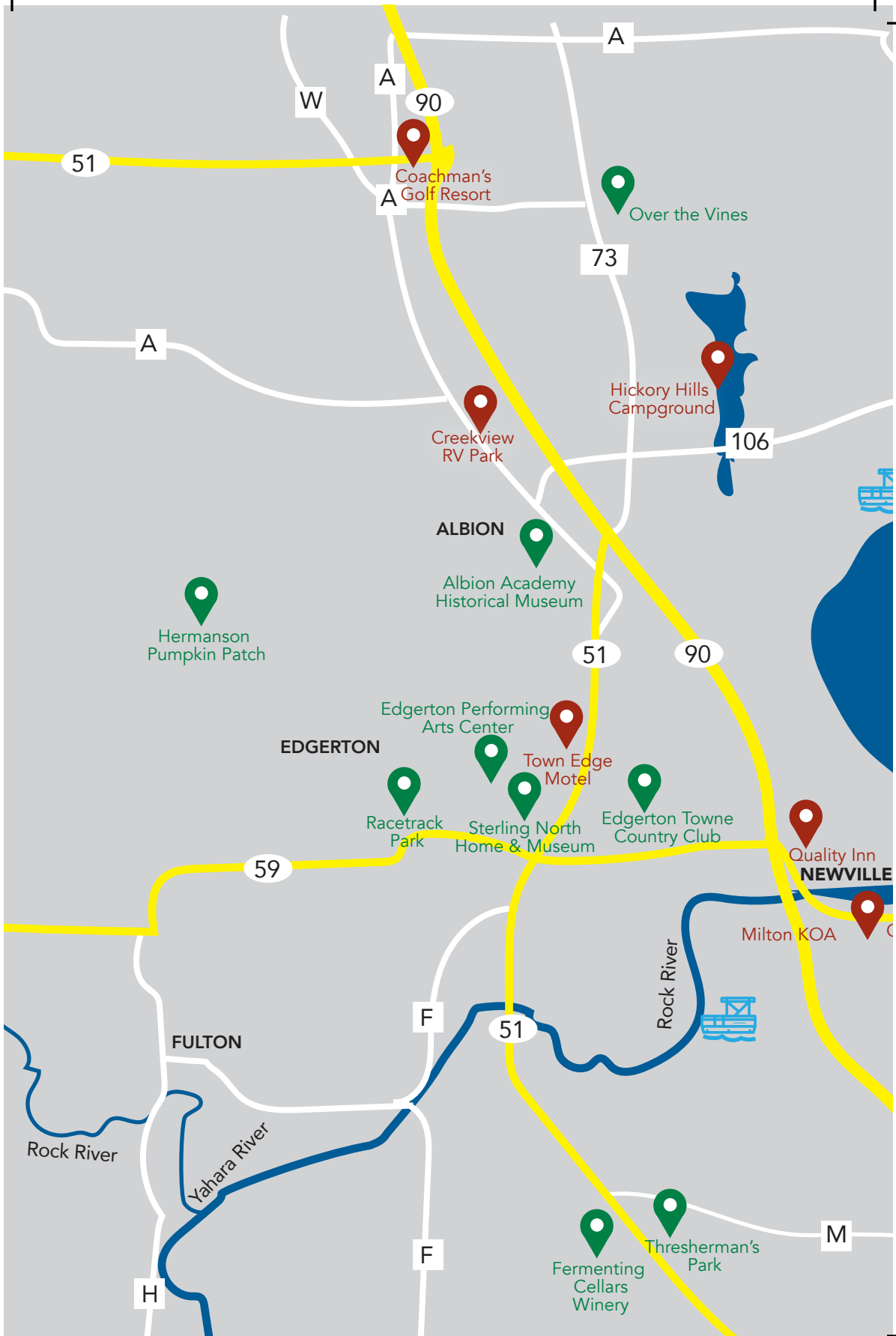
